DESCRIPTION:

- Teaching the classroom, range, and on-the-road portions of the Commercial Truck Driving Curriculum.
- Instructor must maintain documentation on course materials as well as student progress in the courses as required by agency standards and policies.
- A minimum of 28 hours per week.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Valid CLASS A CDL
- Clean seven (7) year Motor Vehicle Report.
- Three years full-time, paid, work experience in field as a commercial truck driver *OR* in the transportation field in the past five years.
- Must have completed preparation in commercial truck driving from a regionally accredited private or public post-secondary school *OR* completed an equivalent military or company-sponsored training program or approved apprenticeship program.
- Must pass drug screen, criminal background check, and MVR check.
- Must demonstrate excellent verbal, written, and interpersonal skills.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Teaching experience at the postsecondary level
- Active participation in appropriate professional/occupational organizations
- Supervisory experience
- Excellent human relations skills
